## **Assessment & Award Regulations**

| 12.   | Absence From In-Course Assessment  |
|-------|--|
| 12.1. | Where a student has an <i>allowable</i> absence, s/he will be marked absent (A) from a summative assessment. Where a student has an A, and there are three or more in-course assessments in the year, the marks awarded will be the average of the other in-course assessment marks gained by the student. |
| 12.2. | 90% of the marks for the year must be attributed to results of direct assessment i.e. no more than 10% of marks can be attributed to Absent (A) marks.   |
| 12.3. | An allowable absence is one that is for a significant unforeseeable event such as illness.   |
| 12.4. | Any other foreseeable absence will only be considered allowable if agreed by Academic Progress Committee (APC) and this will only apply in very strictly limited circumstances.  |
| 12.5. | A student absent for any other reason will be awarded 0 (zero) for the assessment.   |
