## 10. Award and Classification

10.1. The marks from Year 1, 2, 3 and 4 shall be weighted as follows, aggregated and then scaled to a percentage to be used for classification:

10.2. If a student has been admitted with exemption directly to Year 2, the marks from Year 2, 3 and 4 shall be weighted as follows, aggregated and then scaled to give a percentage to be used for classification:
