Level 2 Contextual School	The school at which one completed their (1 st attempt) GCSEs or National 5s falls below the national average for attainment on this measure	-	1
Level 3 Contextual School	The school at which one completed, or is set to complete, their A Levels or Scottish Highers/Advanced Highers falls below the national average for attainment on this measure	-	1
